

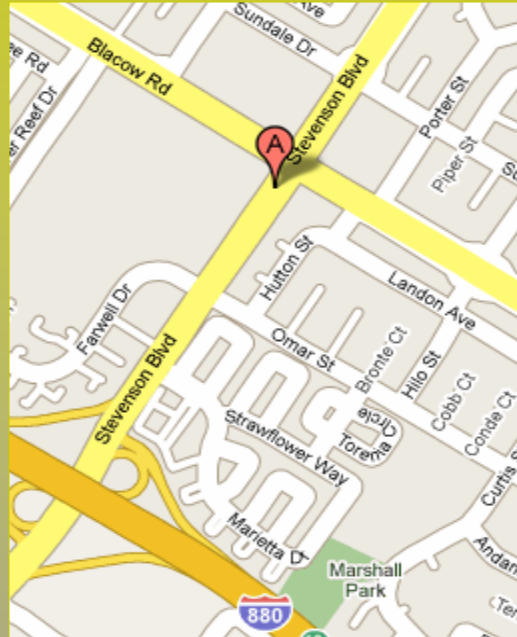
Mission Valley ROP

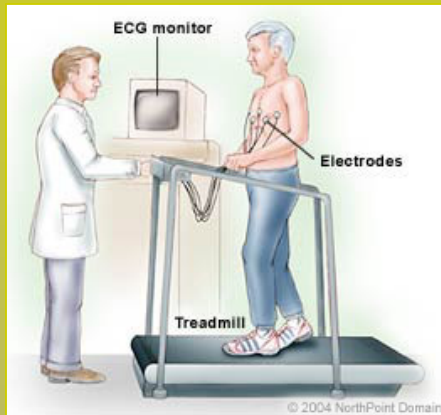

- Build a career in the cardiology department as a cardiovascular technician or cardiovascular technologist



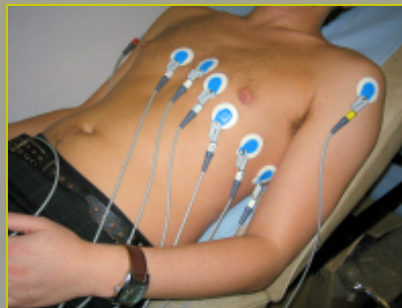

Do you enjoy working with the patients in a hospital?

This two-quarter course covers classroom instruction on basic concepts of the cardiovascular system including anatomy, physiology, and essential skills needed to operate the equipment and interpret an EKG.

During the second quarter, students are placed at Kaiser Hospital locations for an internship during which students work with patients under direct supervision. Students gain on-the-job skills in preparation to join the workforce.

Students are provided the necessary employability and technical skills to succeed in getting employed. Those students interested in pursuing this career are provided with a career pathway leading to high paid positions within the cardiology specialty of medical health professions.
