This course prepares students for entry-level employment in residential and commercial construction. Students receive hands-on training in carpentry, plumbing, electrical, insulation, drywall, taping, concrete work, cabinetry, and floor covering. Students learn power tool use and safety. Students participate in hands-on classroom and community projects.



Students gain skills through in-class instruction, hand-on experience, classroom, and community projects. Integrated throughout the course are career preparation standards, which include workplace basic skills and behaviors, career technical skills, and job employment skills.
