

# Construction Technology 1 & 2

Students will explore and learn the basic skills necessary for the various fields in residential and commercial construction. They will learn carpentry, plumbing, electrical, insulation, drywall, taping, painting, concrete work, cabinetry, and floor covering. Students will learn power tool use and safety. They will be introduced to green construction; including roofing

with solar system installation and application of energy efficient building materials. Students gain skills through in-class instruction, hand-on experience, classroom, and community projects. Integrated throughout the course are career preparation standards, which include workplace basic skills and behaviors, career technical skills, and job employment skills.
