 March 14- March 16, 2016

Background:

MVROP Automotive Technology program students on the James Logan High campus submitted their student-built solar charging station for consideration in the Samsung “Solve for Tomorrow” STEM contest. In December 2015, students and their instructor, Eba Mohammed, were named the California State Winners for the competition and advanced into the next phase of the competition: a video submission and potential national recognition. MVROP students have been named one of the top 15 national finalists for the Samsung “Solve for Tomorrow” competition and will now compete versus students throughout the nation at the Pitch Event in New York. The Pitch Event competition will be held on March 14- March 16, 2016 at the Samsung Offices located in New York, NY.

Current Status:

Two (2) students total from James Logan High will attend this event and will be chaperoned by two (2) certificated staff members. Students will depart on the morning of Monday, March 14, 2016 and will fly to New York. They will stay at the Sheraton Hotel located in Weekawkin, NJ and will return on the evening of Wednesday, March 16, 2016. Students will be transported by the certificated staff members to and from the Sheraton Hotel and where the Pitch Event takes place at the Samsung offices in New York, NY. Students will miss three (3) instructional days for this trip and are responsible for any missed assignments. There will be no swimming during this trip.
