Students will prepare for a career in the healthcare industry. They will study medical ethics, medicine and law, appointment scheduling, telephone techniques, filing methods and record keeping, aseptic concepts, infection control, CPR, vital signs, anthropometric measurements, assisting in various specialties and surgical preparations, medical terminology, and HIPAA rules and practice. Students that successfully complete the first semester with a minimum B (84%) grade and teacher recommendation will be placed in a medical office or clinic for hands-on experience.

- Complete Medical Packets including a physical, proof of negative TB test, updated immunizations, PPD, Flu and COVID vaccinations are required for internships.
- Scrubs will be issued for this course
- A stethoscope is also recommended
- All students not meeting requirement for internship will be dropped at the end of Semester 1.
- Transportation to and from the clinical site is the student's responsibility
