

# Introduction to Engineering Design

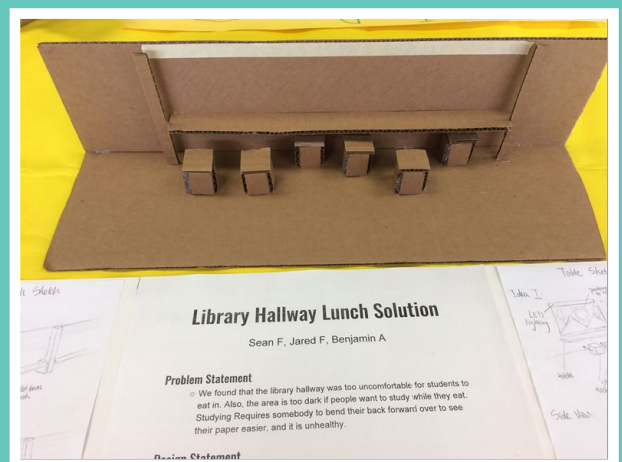

Students use state of the art software to solve real world problems and communicate solutions through hands-on projects and activities.

Guest speakers, field trips, and opportunities to "shadow" professionals in their typical workdays are additional parts of learning in this course.
