The national employment demand for Pharmacy Technicians is expected to grow 4% from 2019 to 2029. This PTCB Recognized Pharmacy Technician course provides high school juniors and seniors preparation for an entry-level career in the pharmaceutical field. While completing this course students will master various job duties required of a



- Filling
- Dispensing
- Insurance
- Medication inventory
- Inpatients
- IV admixtures (Sterile Compounding)
- Pre-pack
- Unit dose
- Communication skills and duties under direction of a pharmacist.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the California hourly wage for Pharmacy Technicians is \$26.79

Students must maintain a B or better and excellent attendance to be eligible for an externship and to continue in Semester 2.

If 18 or older, externship sites will require students to pass a drug test/background check and proof of COVID-19 vaccination may be required.

Upon meeting the class requirements students will take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam® (PTCE®). MVROP will pay for the exam fee. Students who pass the exam are eligible to apply for a Pharmacy Technician license.
