This course gives students the opportunity to gain hands-on experience in multiple health care sites including Nursing Homes (LTC), Assisted/Senior Living, Dementia/Alzheimer Units, Activities/ Recreational Therapy, Rehabilitation Units, Acute Care Rehabilitation (PT & OT), Surgery and Medical/Non-Medical Home Care experiences, etc. Students will obtain clinical/internship hours which are required to apply to many medical professional programs. This course will help students determine what area of practice they want to pursue.

Requirements:

- Own transportation to clinical/internship sites.
- Clean LifeScan fingerprint background check
- Completed Medical Packet (i.e., physical, updated immunizations, PPD and Flu immunizations, proof of COVID-19 vaccinations are required at internship site, etc.)
- Scrubs will be issued for this course
- All students must maintain a B or better with successful completion of class work and attendance or they will not be eligible for an internship and will be dropped at the end of Semester 1.
