Sports Therapy 1







Students will learn the concepts of injury recognition, evaluation, management and rehabilitation. Students will gain practical experience with adhesive taping and protective padding techniques; as well as the use of therapeutic modalities, and emergency first aid procedures as applied to athletic injuries. In addition, students will gain valuable hands-on experience at community classroom sites including physical therapy clinics, chiropractic offices, fitness facilities and athletic training rooms. Students will earn CPR certification. Internships are required. Students must meet all requirements to participate in internships. Note: proof of COVID-19 vaccinations may be required at internship site. An Internship is Required.
