- Meets the UC Area "g' requirement
- Earn an internship at a local health care facility
- Gain hands-on experience in a clinical health-care setting
- Prepare for entry-level employment in a variety of healthcare fields

Students will prepare for entry-level employment opportunities in a variety of medical careers. They will learn professional ethics, medical terminology, infection control, vital signs, basic anatomy, CPR, and special procedures. Students will gain skills to support employment in Physical Therapy, Emergency Service, Pharmacy, Dental, Radiology, Dietary, and Medical Records. During the second semester, students will have the opportunity to be placed in a local hospital or other health care facilities for on-the-job-training during the second semester. Proof of immunization is required for internships at healthcare facilities. Students must provide their own transportation to the clinical sites.
